

The Gatlinburg Board of Commissioners met in a regular meeting on Tuesday June 19, 2018 at 6:00 P.M. in the City Council Room. All members were present. Mayor Mike Werner called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance. The Finance Director Robert Holt gave the Invocation.

Mayor Werner then called for a motion to approve the Minutes of the regular meeting of June 5, 2018. Commissioner Don Smith made a motion to approve the Minutes which was seconded by Commissioner Hannah Helton Harper and then unanimously adopted.

There were no Reports of Boards or Committees.

The City Manager reported and/or requested:

(1) that she would like to announce some exciting activities that are coming up to celebrate the July 4<sup>th</sup> Holiday. The City Manager stated that the Annual 4<sup>th</sup> of July Midnight Parade will kick off the celebration and that the Grand Marshals will be the Gatlinburg-Pittman High School Athletic Department. The City Manager also stated that the 100<sup>th</sup> Army Band will be back again this year with musical performances at the Ripley's Aquarium Plaza on July 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> and the River Raft Regatta will be held on July 4<sup>th</sup> at the Christ in the Smokies Bridge with registration beginning at 10:00 a.m. The 4<sup>th</sup> of July Holiday will wrap up with a Fireworks Display at 10:00 p.m. and fireworks will be shot off from Traffic light #3, but can be seen all over town.


**Mayor Mike Werner**
