## **Gatlinburg and Sevier County to observe One Year Anniversary of Wildfires**

**GATLINBURG, Tenn. (November 1, 2017)** – The City of Gatlinburg and Sevier County will hold a memorial ceremony on Tuesday, November 28 in observance of the one year anniversary of the Wildfires. The ceremony will honor those who lost their lives, recognize first responders and give thanks for the progress made on the community’s recovery in the year following the disaster. The ceremony will also include an announcement about a lasting memorial to remember the 14 who perished on November 28, 2016.

The community is invited to the service which will be held at 5:00 p.m. **on Tuesday, November 28, at the Rocky Top Sports World Complex at 1870 Sports World Blvd** – the venue that helped thousands of Gatlinburg residents and visitors as the community relief shelter in the days following the devastating wildfires.
